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Dear Parent or Guardian:

This letter is to inform you about Holyoke's English language learners' (ELLs) progress toward achieving English proficiency and where you can learn more about the English Language Education (ELE) program at your child's school.

The No Child Left Behind Act requires each state to annually set goals for ELLs in public schools to measure student progress toward learning English. These goals are called the Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs).

The Spring 2011 AMAO results for Holyoke were:


1. **Progress** toward English proficiency,
 - 48% of Holyoke ELLs made progress compared to the state target of 61%.
2. **Attainment** of English proficiency,
 - 22% of all students attained proficiency compared to the 39% district target.
3. **Adequate yearly progress** (AYP) on the **English Language Arts** and **Mathematics** portions of the Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System (MCAS).
 - Holyoke ELLs met the MCAS participation targets; they did not meet performance, improvement, or annual attendance targets in English Language Arts or Mathematics.

The Holyoke Public Schools is dedicated to providing the best education for our English language learners in all grades and levels of proficiency. We regularly assess programs and make adjustments when and where necessary.

We invite you to meet with the English Language Education staff to learn more about the program and services at your child's school. Each of the K-8 and high schools will inform you about when these meetings will take place.
